Maryland University of Integrative Health is currently conducting a search for a part-time adjunct faculty member in Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine to teach *History and Classics in Chinese Medicine* (1.25 credits), both face-to-face and online (future). The course requires a philosophical and scholarly understanding of the Chinese Medical Classics, in particular, the Huang Ti Nei Ching, and the History of Chinese Medicine from China to America. Some knowledge of Chinese characters and their relevance for understanding philosophical and medical concepts is helpful as well as an ability to translate this early written text to modern notions of health and wellness.

The position is available in January 2016 and may lead to opportunities for advancement and promotion as the AOM program continues to grow.
