Maryland University of Integrative Health is seeking knowledgeable and dedicated individuals to serve as instructors in integrative health science courses (e.g. anatomy, physiology, pathophysiology, biochemistry, mind-body science, research literacy, CAM survey course). Integrative Health Sciences provides foundational coursework to help students analyze and explain the interconnection between personal health and the social and ecological environments; explain health and disease from a "whole-person" (biopsychosocial) perspective; and evaluate the scientific rationale and evidence for diverse systems and modalities of health care. Instructors contribute broad university service through student advising, committee work, and scholarship and professional development.

This full-time position is required to apply for rank under MUIH's Appointment, Rank, and Promotion policy within two ranking cycles.

Responsibilities/Duties

Responsibilities/duties include, but are not limited to:

- Developing and teaching on-campus and/or online courses in graduate curriculum, including creating syllabi, lesson plans, and assessments appropriate for graduate level coursework (i.e., incorporating critical thinking and information literacy), integrating computing, academic technologies, and the university learning management system into the subject material
- Assessing student learning outcomes, including grading and reviewing assignments
- Monitoring student progress and grades
- Preparing and duplicating student materials
- Participating in faculty meetings as well as academic and university committees
- Being available for individual coaching/advising of students as required
- Participating in department related events as appropriate
- Engaging in collaborative relationships to promote positive community relations on behalf of MUIH and Integrative Health Sciences programs
- Demonstrating professional knowledge, attitudes, skills, and standards of conduct
- Performing other duties as assigned
