These important members of the instructional community, versed in integrative and evidence-based nutrition practice, support the learning experience of Nutrition and Integrative Health students and the delivery of safe and effective patient care in a simulated teaching clinic. Each Lead Online Clinical Strategies Supervisor creates a supportive learning environment for Nutrition and Integrative Health graduate students and guides and supervises students during clinical practice. The Lead Online Clinical Strategies Supervisor is one of the faculty contacts throughout the student's clinical training.

Each position is part-time and consists of weekly or biweekly online clinic shifts.

Responsibilities/Duties

Responsibilities/duties include, but are not limited to:

- Oversee and coordinate graduate students participating in the simulated online clinic activities by utilizing student case review presentations over Skype
- Ensure and contribute such that each student receives appropriate instruction, mentoring, supervision, progress monitoring, and feedback during their clinical training utilizing the nutrition care process (assessment, nutrition diagnosis, intervention, monitoring and evaluation)
- Ensure that students can design effective treatment plans and prioritize care
- Discern and remember the distinction between one's own practice and a beginner's practice when supervising graduate student
- Offer support, coaching, and motivation to facilitate students' successful completion of the clinical experience
- Ensure that all student learning outcomes, assignments, policies, and procedures as outlined in the syllabus are met
- Uphold HIPPA privacy regulations
- Approve and verify that the clinical progress notes of students meet the current standards established by the simulated online clinic

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- Attend beginning of the trimester orientations (via conference call)
- Model professional demeanor, clinical skills, and ethical behavior for graduate students
- Serve as faculty advisor throughout the student's online simulated clinical experience
- Perform other duties as assigned

Qualifications

Required:

- Master's Degree or higher in Nutrition, Dietetics, or related field
- Certification as a nutritionist, dietician, or other licensed healthcare professional
- Minimum of 5 years of experience in a practice focused on nutrition and integrative health related equivalent (i.e., integrative nutrition, functional nutrition, complementary nutrition, holistic nutrition, etc.)
- Professional demeanor
- Excellent clinical abilities with a willingness to learn new skills
- Proficient practice management skills
- Highly developed interpersonal and communication skills
- Commitment to maintain credentials and continuing education units as part of professional licensure
- Have computer, stable internet connection, webcam, and headset needed to complete student case review presentations over Skype
- Alignment with the University's mission and values
