Keeping Pace with Rapid Expansion and Growing Enrollment

In 2009, Maryland University of Integrative Health decided to embark upon an ambitious plan to significantly expand academic offerings, attract and retain the best and most talented faculty, and achieve university status. By the end of 2013, we had achieved each of these goals. In just four years, our academic programming has grown from four degree and certificate programs to 18, and enrollment has nearly doubled to 800 graduate students. Also in 2013, we earned university status, making MUIH the only regionally-accredited university on the East Coast exclusively dedicated to integrative health and natural wellness.

As we look to 2015 and beyond, we have plans to continue expanding our academic offerings as well as increasing our graduate student enrollment. This growth, while exciting, presents the challenge of building the infrastructure necessary to support responsible expansion. Our current technology is already stretched, and will soon be inadequate to support our needs. In order to be the university-of-choice in integrative health, we cannot just build cutting-edge programs; we must also build the technology infrastructure to match our progress and support our growth.

Providing Current Students, Faculty and Staff with Advanced Technology

Contributions to this technology fund will enable MUIH to build exciting and up-to-date technology resources for our campus and online community. This state-of-the-art infrastructure will include video conferencing, an audio system, interactive white boards, document cameras, plasma screens, and a high performance phone system that includes an expansion to a satellite campus. In addition, we will enhance our cloud backup and storage capacities, and enact an internet redundancy solution.

This initial investment will significantly enhance our capacity to deliver the highest caliber programs to our students and use effective and efficient communication vehicles to maintain our connections.
