Essential responsibilities:

- Performs acupuncture needle therapy and other Chinese medical modalities that fall within scope of practice, including but not limited to, electrical current, moxabustion, tui-na, herbal remedies, and essential oils
- Functions within the interdisciplinary team, contributing to diagnosis and coordination of treatment plan options
- Provides timely documentation and maintains appropriate medical records documentation for treatments and services rendered
