IMPORTANT REGISTRATION DATES

Registration for Summer 2024 begins on January 29, 2024

Registration Deadline: March 24, 2024

It is still possible to register for courses after the registration deadline, but late fees may apply.

Late Registration Fees for Continuing* Students: Beginning March 25, 2024

\$75/course after the registration deadline and before the Schedule Adjustment Period.

\$150/course during the Schedule Adjustment Period.

**There are no late registration fees for new students (registering for their first trimester).*

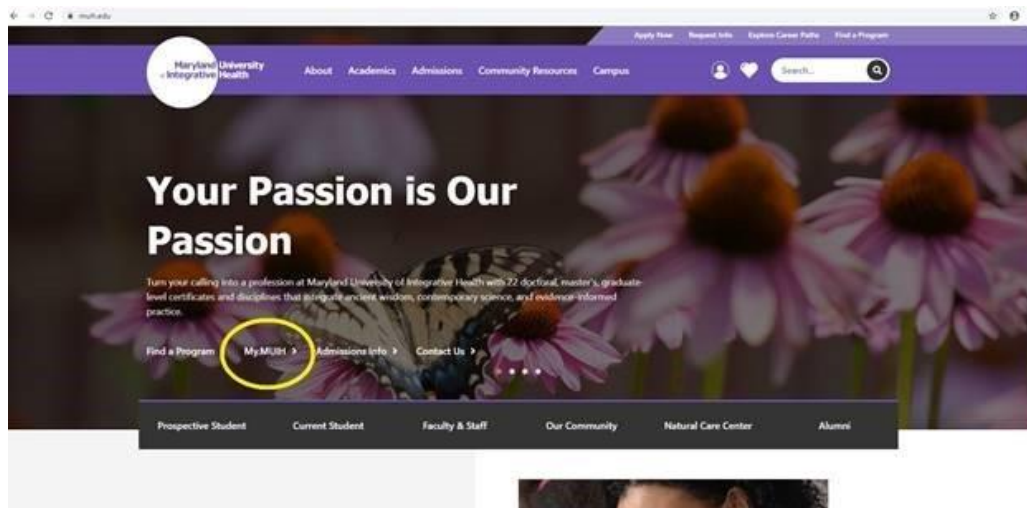

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please note that the main page of the MUIH website has changed since this video was recorded. To access My MUIH, simply go to the public MUIH website and click on "My MUIH," which you can see circled here:



Steps:

1. Verify your upcoming trimester course schedule with your **Academic Advisor**. Prior to meeting with your advisor, be sure to review your **Plan of Study** and Curriculum Progression Report which is located under "My Curricula" in the **data portal**.
To access your plan of study, go to **MyMUIH.edu**
 - (a) **Click** on "Academics"
 - (b) **Select** your program from the dropdown
 - (c) **Click** on "Plans of Study"
 - (d) **Select** your intake year
 - (e) **Review** your upcoming trimester courses
2. Log into your **MUIH Data Portal** with your MUIH login credentials
3. On the left-hand side, select the "Course Registration" button
4. In the search box, type the course code (test with and without a space)
5. Review **course schedule information**
 - a. Please note that on-campus classes are sections 1-99, hybrid classes are sections 100-199, asynchronous online classes are sections 200-299, and synchronous online classes are 300-399.
6. Select "Register" and **verify your enrollment** by going to "My Courses" button

***For program- or course-specific** information, please visit **Program and Course-Specific Information**.

**** Registration Flags:** Please allow up to 96 hours for all flagged courses to be reviewed and approved or denied by your program's department.

Nutrition & Herbal Medicine Students

Cooking Lab Kits for Nutrition Students

A cooking lab kit is provided for every student who registers for NUTR681 Cooking with Whole Foods Lab I. The kit consolidates supplies used in all cooking labs, so it's a one-time purchase assessed with tuition.

Students registering for an in-person section of NUTR681 (Section 1) will receive their cooking kit during the lab. Students registering for an online section of NUTR681 (Sections 200+) will receive their kits by mail. These students must verify that their mailing address is up-to-date prior to sending by checking the **My Contact Information** section of the MyMUIH Data Portal no later than the end of the Schedule Adjustment Period. Cooking lab kits are sent the second week of the trimester to ensure they arrive in plenty of time for the course. Students registered for the course should check their email for more information about the cooking lab kits, as there are special considerations for those living outside the continental United States and Canada. If a student receives a cooking lab kit and later decides to drop or withdraw from NUTR681, they should simply retain the kit. They won't receive or be charged for a second kit whenever they are able to re-register for the course.

HRB 636 Botany Intensive

HRB 636 *Botany Intensive* is a hybrid course requiring online and in-person participation. Students will take part in a field trip at the United Plant Savers in Ohio. A \$175 fee will be assessed for this course to cover food and lodging costs. More details about the field trip will be provided by the course instructor.

Required Courses for New Students

MUIH 500: University Wide Orientation for New Students:

University-Wide New Student Orientation is a comprehensive course to introduce incoming MUIH students to campus services, resources, and student life. Utilizing the institution's Learning Management System (LMS) Canvas, it is a self-paced course designed around you the new student, assisting you in learning the answers to questions you may have, and providing you with a chance to meet and connect with other new students as well.

MUIH 550: Academic Research & Scholarship:

This fully online, self-paced course is designed to prepare students to engage in graduate-level research and scholarship with a focus on the utilization of resources available at or through

MUIH's Sherman Cohn Library. Modules cover the Association of College and Research Libraries information literacy threshold concepts in higher education. These concepts are: Scholarship as Conversation, Research as Inquiry, Authority is Constructed and Contextual, Information Creation as a Process, Searching as Strategic Exploration, and Information Has Value.
