Lauren Kingsland Master of Arts in Applied Healing Arts

Lauren is an Artist in Residence for the Arts and Humanities Program at the <u>Georgetown University Hospital Lombardi</u> <u>Cancer Center</u>. As a fiber artist and a practitioner of healing arts, she provides hand-on creative engagement projects and mindfulness activities to patients, caregivers, and staff. The needle is an important tool in her work which includes sewing, quilting, crochet, beaded bracelets, origami cranes, and prayer flags. Lauren now uses online classes and videos to continue to offer this connection and support through the AHP during the pandemic.

Lauren teaches fiber arts techniques as tools for mindfulness and connection through the <u>Smithsonian Associates Studio Arts</u> <u>program</u>, now online through Smithsonian Associates Streaming. She maintains a private studio in Washington Grove, MD for commissions and individual instruction, these days through Zoom. She received her BA from Stephens College in Classical Greek and Mathematics, as well as training in painting and design.

If you have ever attended an educational seminar, clinical workshop, or read an editorial written by a clinical professional, you've likely been exposed to expert advice. More than ever, experts may also share information online through blogs, vlogs, and even social media. Policymakers and the general public also place stock in expert advice, so it can also have considerable influence on public health measures too. Expert advice (or opinion) generally refers to evidence, information, or guidance given by someone who's work has made them an authority in their field. Clinical experts could be academics, specialists, or practicing clinicians, who have spent a considerable amount of time studying one area of interest. However, that doesn't mean that everyone calling themselves an expert truly meets these criteria. So, how do you know whether a piece of so-called expert advice is worth implementing in your practice?
