Rabab Al-Amim Master of Acupuncture, Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Chinese Herbs

Rabab is a Licensed Acupuncturist, Chinese Herbalist, Zero Balancer, Sound Healer, Medical Astrologer, and owner of Hunt Valley Acupuncture and Herbal Medicine. In her practice, she specializes in family medicine. She uses Five Element acupuncture, Chinese herbs, Zero Balancing, and sound healing to treat the whole person and address a variety of conditions that range from sports injuries, women's health, tick-borne illnesses, depression, burnout, fatigue, PTSD, infertility, to general wellness to support the immune system and maintain health. She established Hummingbird Potions, her herbal line of medicinal salves, lineaments, and tinctures in 2011.

She received her bachelor's degree in English Literature from Mustansiriyah University in Baghdad, Iraq, her certification in Cardiac Sonography from Johns Hopkins Bay View Medical Center in Baltimore, Maryland. She helped establish the Echocardiography Department at the Ultrasound School at John Hopkins Hospital. She also served as Vice President of Public Affairs for the Maryland Acupuncture Society and previously served as faculty at the Maryland University of Integrative Health.

IN RECOGNITION OF WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH: WOMEN HEALERS IN HISTORY



Wu (female shamans) dominated the practice of medicine in ancient China, Japan, and Korea.

Approx 620 CE Rufaida Al-Aslamia

was the first known nurse and field surgeon in what is now Saudia Arabia. She is thought tto have been the Islamic Prophet Muhammad's preferred medical expert and ordered casualties to her medical tent. She also worked as a social worker to prevent disease in the community.

1865-1915 CE Dr. Susan La Flesche Picotte

was the first American Indian woman to receive a medical degree in the United States. After witnessing a sick Indian woman die because the local white doctor denied medical care, she was inspired to apply to the Woman's Medical College of Pennsylvania so she could serve her community.

1920s CE Dr. Margaret Chung

was the first Chinese American woman to become a physician. As a Christian, she applied to be a medical missionary after graduating from the University of Southern California but was rejected because of her race. She became a medical resident in the Chicago area and later returned to California to practice. Her private practice became popular with the Hollywood elite. After volunteering to serve as a front-line surgeon during the Sino- Japanese War. She later used her influence to lobby for the creation of WAVES (Women Accepted for Volunteer Emergency Service). However, her own application to join WAVES was rejected due to her race and sexuality.

Arthur William Lazarowitz Former MUIH Adjunct Faculty July-29, 1933- March 1, 2021



Arthur (Art) William Lazarowitz passed away in his home in Columbia, Maryland on Monday, March 1st, 2021 at the age of 87 years. Arthur is predeceased by his mother and father, Lena and Leo Lazarowitz, many cousins and his beloved fiancée, Denise (Teddy) Rogers, his soulmate.

Arthur is survived by his two daughters, Esther R. Lazarowitz and Evelyn H. Adams, along with his exwife, Sonja M. Lazarowitz. He is also survived by his two sisters, Lucy Biem (Howie) and Linda Lazarowitz, and brother, Harvey A. Lazar, along with two nieces, Julie and Jean.

Arthur was born in New York City on July 29th, 1933. After high school, he served four years in the U.S. Navy as a Sonarman during the Korean War. He then went on to earn a Teaching degree from Albany State University and taught History and Political Science until he decided to pursue and earned a Law degree from Buffalo State University. After moving to Washington, D.C. and briefly working for the I.R.S, he found his dream job with the Department of the Interior U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. After he retired from the government, he was inspired by his love, Teddy Rogers, to pursue further education in the field of acupuncture and found that helping people heal physically and spiritually was his calling. He spent many years traveling to Hawaii to further his own spiritual growth and healing abilities.

Arthur was an avid tennis player, swimmer, N.Y. sports fan and enjoyed long walks in nature. For his love of community, he was a prominent patron of David's Natural Market in Columbia, Maryland where he communed with friends and acquaintances, sharing his time and offering healings to all those in need.

His greatest wish was for unity and world peace.

Letter from the Provost/2020-2021 Commencement Update

MUIH Community:

I am writing to update you on planning for **MUIH's 2020-2021 Commencement ceremony**. I wrote to you In November to inform you that we had moved the 2020-2021 ceremony from May 2021 to June 27, 2021. We made that decision based on our commitment to hold a memorable in person ceremony and because the later June date would maximize the chances that we would be able to hold an in-person event based on the state of the COVID-19 pandemic at that time. The pandemic has again caused us to adjust our scheduled events.

We have now decided to move the 2020-2021 Commencement ceremony from June 2021 to October 24, 2021. We remain committed to preserving an in-person Commencement ceremony and providing graduates with the opportunity to participate in this traditional and special celebration. However, based on guidance from our venue operator about their likely inability to host the event in June, and the need for health and safety precautions for the next several months we need to move the ceremony to a later date in Fall 2021 when we expect that it will again be possible for us to come together and celebrate. It is very important for us to hold an in-person commencement ceremony in 2021 and we apologize for needing to change the date of the event in order to ensure this happens.

Our adjusted plans include the following:

June 26, 2021: We will conduct our Awards Ceremony and Graduate Recognition online. The Awards ceremony honors our student, faculty, and staff award recipients in a variety of categories. The Graduate Recognition provides graduates with the opportunity to reflect on their studies at MUIH and share their story with others on our Commencement website.

October 24, 2021: We will conduct our Commencement Ceremony in person at the Lyric Theater in Baltimore. Graduates from 2020 and 2021 will be invited to participate and be honored at this ceremony (this includes individuals who graduated during the period of Summer 2019 through Summer 2021).

Additional information about these events will be made available as they become available.

MUIH takes great pride in the accomplishments of its graduates and anticipates the many contributions they will make as professionals who bring the principles of integrative health and wellness to their communities. We look forward to celebrating the accomplishments, resilience, and perseverance of our graduates and community.
