<u>Asalha Puja Day</u>

Commemorates the historical Buddha's first discourse following his spiritual awakening.

4

<u>Fourth of July</u> - Independence Day

Anniversary of the United States Declaration of Independence in 1776.

9

Martyrdom of the Bab

Observance of the anniversary of the execution by a firing squad in Tabriz, Persia, of the 30-year-old Siyyid Ali-Muhammad, the Bab, the prophet-herald of the Baha'i faith.

14

Bastille Day

Common name given to the French National Day, which is celebrated on July 14 each year.

18

Nelson Mandela International Day

Named for Nelson Mandela, human rights lawyer and international peacemaker in South Africa.

19

<u>Al Hijra and Muharram</u>

The prophet Muhammad's move from Mecca to Medina in 622 CE is observed as the start of the New Islamic Year. It is a period of grief and mourning of the son of Ali and grandson of Muhammad.

National Disability Independence Day

Commemorates the signing of the Americans with Disabilities Act in 1990 guaranteeing equal opportunity for people with disabilities.

Tish'a B'av

Mourning of the destruction of the First and Second Temples in Jerusalem in 586 BCE and 70 CE.

28

Buffalo Soldiers Day

Honors the first peacetime all-Black army regiment to keep order in the Wild West after the Civil War.

30

International Day of Friendship

Promotes the role that friendship plays in promoting peace in many cultures.
