## State Licensure Determination

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## Introduction

On November 1, 2019, the U.S. Department of Education published a final rule, which included consumer disclosure requirements for programs that prepare students for professional licensure and certification. The rule went into effect on July 1, 2020.

If an educational program is designed to meet educational requirements for a specific professional license or certification that is required for employment in an occupation, Regulation 34 CFR 668.43(a)(5)(v) requires institutions to disclose to prospective and enrolled students:

- (A) A list of all States for which the institution has determined that its curriculum meets the State educational requirements for licensure or certification;
- (B) A list of all States for which the institution has determined that its curriculum does not meet the State educational requirements for licensure or certification; and
- (C) A list of all States for which the institution has not made a determination that its curriculum meets the State educational requirements for licensure or certification.

This State Licensure Disclosures document provides information about (A), (B), and (C) above for Maryland University of Integrative Health's programs leading to professional licensure.
