### Registration Step 1: Plan of Study




### Registration Step 2: Login to Self-Service Portal

### Registration Step 3: Select Course Search


 Select "Course Search" to access the list of courses for the term you are trying to register for.



### Registration Step 4: Get Full Course List

- A. Select "Advanced Search"
- B. Select term "Spring 2025-MUIH"
- C. Click on "Search"


- The full course list will load once you select the correct term.


## Registration Step 5: Check the Add Button

- Your screen should load as seen below. If your "Add" button is not blue, please contact <a href="mailto:advising@muih.edu">advising@muih.edu</a>.
- Avoid using "Filters" as they may affect the course list being populated accurately.
- To add a course to your schedule you must click the blue "Add" button.




### Registration Step 6: Select Add Section

• Once the dialogue box loads as seen below, select "Add Section" to make sure it gets added to your planned courses for the term.



## Registration Step 7: Complete Registration, Part 1

- A. Select "Academics"
- B. Select "Register/View Class Schedule"
- C. The course (s) will populate under the term you are registering for as planned courses.





### Registration Step 8: Complete Registration, Part 2

- A. To view all planned courses, click "Timeline"
- B. Select the term you are registering for.
- C. Select "Register".

### **Notes**

- The last step (C) will change the course status from "PLANNED" to "ENROLLED".
- If your courses do not say "ENROLLED" you are not registered.
- Clicking "Register" completes the process.





### **Common Registration Problems**

**Courses Requiring Pre-Requisites** - If you are attempting to register for a course that has a pre-requisite and you are either currently in the course in Fall 2024 or have already completed the course, you may receive an error message. We are working with NDMU to address this issue for all students. Until it is resolved please contact your assigned advisor should you encounter this error.

**Unable to Register for Spring Term Courses** - If you are trying to register directly from the schedule or catalog, you may only see Summer/ Fall term available, please be sure to use instructions above. If you are still having issues, please email <a href="mailto:advising@muih.edu">advising@muih.edu</a>.

**Waitlists** – If the course you are registering for has a waitlist, it is because there is another identical section available. This is used as an effort to fill the first section first before the waitlist section. If the course you are attempting to register for is full, please do not add yourself to a waitlist. There should be another section of the course, if there is not another section, please email <a href="mailto:advisng@muih.edu">advisng@muih.edu</a>.

### **Virtual Drop-In Registration Sessions**

Join the Spring 2025 Virtual Registration Drop-In Sessions if any of the following apply to you:

- You're a new student
- You're a student who was on a voluntary break in enrollment (VBE) in summer 2024 to fall 2024
- You don't know how to set up your NDMU email account (which you need to access the registration portal)
- You can't log in to the NDMU Self-Service Portal to register
- You don't see the classes for Spring 2025 listed, or you don't see Spring 2025 as an option to register
- You can't navigate the registration system, or you receive errors when you attempt to register for a course

You can drop into these sessions at any time during the specified meeting time and leave when your problem has been addressed. You do not need to stay for the whole 2-hour session.
